



Coronation Flower Pattern Knitting 1

Make in either red, white or blue

Yarn: DK

Needles size: 4mm

Spare needle or stitch holder

Darning needle (to sew up)



Cast on 126 stitches

Even Rows 2-16: Purl to last 4 sts, turn placing these 4 sts on a spare needle or stitch holder

Row 1: K2, K3tog, K4, K3tog, K6, K3tog, K8, K3tog, K10, K3tog, K12, K3tog, K14, K3tog, K16, K3tog, K18, K3tog, K9 (108 sts)

Row 3: K2, K3tog, K4, K3tog, K6, K3tog, K8, K3tog, K10, K3tog, K12, K3tog, K14, K3tog, K16, K3tog, K8 (88 sts)

Row 5: K2, K3tog, K4, K3tog, K6, K3tog, K8, K3tog, K10, K3tog, K12, K3tog, K14, K3tog, K7 (70 sts)

Row 7: K2, K3tog, K4, K3tog, K6, K3tog, K8, K3tog, K10, K3tog, K12, K3tog, K6 (54 sts)

Row 9: K2, K3tog, K4, K3tog, K6, K3tog, K8, K3tog, K10, K3tog, K5 (40 sts)

Row 11: K2, K3tog, K4, K3tog, K6, K3tog, K8, K3tog, K4 (28 sts)

Row 13: K2, K3tog, K4, K3tog, K6, K3tog, K3 (18 sts)

Row 15: K2, K3tog, K4, K3tog, K2 (10 sts)

Row 17: K2, K3tog, K1 (4 sts)

Row 18: Purl across all sts, then purl across all the stitches on the holder (40 sts)

Row 19: K2tog across (20 Sts)

Cast off and roll the knitting to make a rose. Sew together to secure.
